AVA NATIONAL INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP CHANGES

During the AVA Regular Membership Meeting Club members voted to Amend our bylaws replacing Associate members with Individual members and entitling Individual members with most of the same benefits as Club members including the right to vote. This means everyone over the age of 18 who is a member of the AVA National Organization can now vote on any business brought before the AVA Membership. The one benefit that does not extend to Individual members is the right to conduct or sponsor AVA sanctioned events.

In light of these Bylaws changes, Associate and Family membership categories no longer exist. The only categories that now exist are Regular Club Members, State Association Members, Individual Members and Honorary Members. Honorary members may not conduct, or sponsor AVA sanctioned events or vote at meetings of the members.

The AVA National Individual membership cost is \$25.00 per person and includes the following benefits:

Lifetime members will continue to receive all the same Lifetime Membership benefits and are now also voting members of the organization. They do not need to do anything further.

FROM THE DESK OF THE NATIONAL FINANCE CHAIR

As the National Finance Chair, I help oversee the financial health of our organization and want to make sure every local club is set up for success. Managing finances can feel overwhelming—especially for smaller nonprofits with budgets under \$10,000—and it's easy to run into common pitfalls that cause stress or compliance issues.

I've spent years working with nonprofits and community organizations, helping them manage budgets, stay compliant, and make the most of their resources. I also understand that some clubs have just 2–4 people doing everything, and it can be hard to know where to start.

That's why I'm putting together this series: simple, practical tips to help your club avoid common financial mistakes and stay strong for the long run. Each tip is easy to follow and designed for real-world challenges.

#1 Make Sure Multiple People Have Account Access

Avoid Single Point of Failure

If only one person has access to your bank account, you risk major disruption if they leave or become unavailable. Always have at least two authorized signers and shared view-only access for transparency.

Quick Start Checklist:

- \checkmark Add at least two signers to your bank account
- ✓ Set up (at minimum) online view-only access for the treasurer and president
- ✓ Document account access in your policies


