AVA NATIONAL INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP CHANGES

During the AVA Regular Membership Meeting Club members voted to amend our Bylaws replacing Associate members with Individual members and entitling Individual members with most of the same benefits as Club members including the right to vote. This means everyone over the age of 18 who is a member of the AVA National Organization can now vote on any business brought before the AVA Membership. The one benefit that does not extend to Individual members is the right to conduct or sponsor AVA sanctioned events.

In light of these Bylaws changes, Associate and Family membership categories no longer exist. The only categories that now exist are Regular Club Members, State Association Members, Individual Members and Honorary Members. Honorary members may not conduct, or sponsor AVA sanctioned events or vote at meetings of the members.

The AVA National Individual membership cost is \$25.00 per person and includes the following benefits:

- A 10% discount on most AVA merchandise.
- A 10% discount on our National Conventions registration full package and other signature events hosted by the National Office.
- An annual subscription to The American Wanderer (TAW), a national walk publication of the AVA.
- † The opportunity to participate in the Centurion Challenge Program
- È Each AVA Individual member is entitled to participate in AVA Membership meetings.
- **†** Each AVA Individual adult (18+ years) member is entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote of the members.

Although Family membership was never an official AVA membership category, we will continue to offer AVA Individual members the benefit to enroll up to two family members, under the age of 18 and living in the same household, as a family member for an additional nominal price of \$5.00 per family member.

Family members are not Individual members and must be under the age of 18 and therefore not entitled to vote. However, they are eligible for all other benefits. Should you have any questions please contact Erin at erin@ava.org

MY MOTHER'S JOURNEY - ANONYMOUS AVA MEMBER

PLANNING EVENTS FOR 2026

The year 2026 will be a monumental year for several reasons, why not plan walks around some of the events. A few dates to commemorate are:

- AVA will celebrate the 50th Anniversary:
 - - AVA was chartered as an associate member by IVV on April 30, 1976
 - - First Walk: In Fredericksburg TX June 12 and 13, 1976 as the Texas Walk Fest
 - - Forty-seven years ago: The first National Walking Convention was in Dayton OH on June 16, 1979 where the AVA name was adopted
 - - Ten years ago, many AVA office members came to the National Office.
- The United States will celebrate its 250th Anniversary
- Rails-to-Trails will celebrate their 40th Anniversary. Many local clubs incorporate trails created under this program in their club walks.

In 2026 the Rails-to-Trails Conservancy (RTC) will celebrate their 7th Anniversary. The RTC has a major initiative underway to establish a trail 3,700 miles long from Washington DC to Washington State. The "Great American Trail". To assist in identifying existing trails, the RTC website provides "TrailLink," an online application that provides trail information nationwide.

I understand the AVA Nation wants to celebrate the AVA 50th Anniversary in all ten AVA Regions during 2026. More information will be coming out about the many celebrations. Also, many local clubs plan to designate events as celebrating the AVA Anniversary. The more opportunities to get out and walk the better. Lets plan a great 2026!

Walk As A Group!

Group walks attract attention, and - new members!! People gravitate to the social connections and also, many feel safer in a group. Current members can start growing your club by bringing guests from their condo, or HOA.


Here are three ways you can structure groups walks:

- a. Walk your own Year-Round / Seasonals. This is a no-brainer but not something we all do. If you sponsor several YRE/SE you can rotate through those regularly.
- b. Traveling Guided Walk. If you have only a few YRE sanctioned, or they are spread far and wide, consider the Traveling Guided Walk sanctioning device, which allow a club to hold multiple guided walks on different routes in their area when there aren't sufficient year-round or seasonal events close by and they do not expect enough participation to cover the sanctioning costs of normal guided walks Events may be offered with the following conditions:
 - The club will receive an IVV stamp that they may use for the rest of the year at multiple guided walks. The participation fee will be the same as usually paid for IVV credit. Each event must be sanctioned.
 - The IVV stamp for Traveling Guided Walk (TGW) events may be renewed for subsequent years by sanctioning a Traveling Guided Walk for the next year and paying the current fee.
 - Traveling Guided Walk events may not be held on currently sanctioned year-round or seasonal walk routes and clubs must not eliminate current year-round or seasonal walk routes.

c. ACE-WG. "Fun Walks" . Did know that America's Walking Club created a specific event format called AVA Community Events - Weekday Guided, or ACE-WG for short. This format allows you to hold events tailor-made for recruiting new members, covered by AVA's national insurance policy but at no cost to the participants (if you want). ACE-WG events are designed to encourage weekly participation on a regular basis. Fun walks, guided walks, meet ups, etc., are examples of events that could fall into this category. ACE events are NOT IVV approved, so there are no stamps for IVV credit associated with ACE.

5. SAVE THE DATE: The Big Give, AVA's annual fundraiser, is September 17 at 6pm through September 18 at 6pm. As we are making plans for the 50th anniversary of volkswalking in the United States in 2026 (the first event was in Fredericksburg, TX in 1976), your donation will help AVA with our 50th celebration, to help support the clubs and individuals who have committed to a special multi-day regional event – one each month in 2026. But AVA is also the backbone for those who have a passion for volkswalking, and this annual campaign helps the organization continue to provide insurance for all clubs' events, maintain the website, work on innovative solutions to keep our sport up-to-date with technology, and so much more. We will send more information in the next few weeks about the fundraiser.
